DRAFT Description:

Designing, installing, and maintaining landscapes with water efficiency is vital to local jurisdictions, agencies, and water purveyors. Landscape irrigation is the single largest use of potable water in the U.S. During summer months, outdoor water use creates peak demand on existing water supplies and system capacity. Water purveyors and utilities must increase supply as much as three to four times the amount used for domestic needs during the winter. Model standards offer a menu of options for water efficient irrigation and landscape requirements.
