Welcome and Introductions – President Terry Pickel called the meeting to order at 1:35 pm.

Agenda Additions or Revisions – No changes were requested.

**IWAC By-Laws** - IWAC Past President, Dan Kegley and IWAC Secretary Rob Lindsay conducted a comprehensive review of the By-Laws which were written in 2012 and have not been reviewed since their adoption. The By-Laws with tracked changes were sent to members prior to the meeting. Secretary Lindsay reviewed all of the suggested edits with the members present. Each section of the By-Laws was carefully discussed. BiJay Adams moved to accept the changes as discussed. Rick Neal seconded the motion. Secretary Lindsay will make all of the agreed upon changes and send the tracked changes out to the members for review prior to the April 13<sup>th</sup> meeting. Members will discuss any further changes and vote on the updated by-laws at the April 13, 2021 meeting.

**2021 Budget and Social Media Boosting –** The 2021 budget review was tabled until April 13, 2021.

**Updates Around the Table**: Updates were tabled until the April meeting. However, a few items of immediate interest were shared.

BiJay Adams reported that it was brought to the attention of the Aquifer Protection District that developers in the Remington Water District Service Area are creating small cluster water supply systems to serve 4-5 lots and avoid connecting to the Remington Water District. DEQ was contacted but did not intervene.

Retired Past President Dan Kegley reported, for full disclosure, that he has agreed to serve as a Water Resource Consultant for GSI Water Solutions.

The Aquifer Protection District is accepting project proposals until the end of March.

Adjourn - There being no further business this 9th day of March 2021, President Pickel adjourned the meeting at 3:53 pm.
